Candidates are requested to read the advertisement carefully and should satisfy themselves about meeting the eligibility criteria before applying for the position.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- The above posts shall carry usual allowances as admissible to CSIR/GOI employees, as have been made applicable to CSIR employees of the same status stationed at CSIR-NEIST Jorhat.
- Age relaxation shall be applicable as per the Government of India Rules. The upper age limit is relaxable upto 05(five) years for SC/ST and 03(three) years for OBC as per Government orders in force only in those cases where the posts are reserved for respective categories, on production of relevant certificate in the format prescribed by Govt. of India signed by the appropriate competent authority at the time of written test/trade test/ skill test.
 - Upper age limit for persons with disabilities shall be relaxable by
 - 10 Years (15 years for SC/ST and 13 years for OBC candidates) subject to the condition that maximum age of the applicant on the last date of receipt of application shall not exceed 56 years.

- Relaxation in age limit shall be applicable irrespective of the fact whether the post is reserved or not, provided the post is identified suitable for persons with disabilities.
 - The persons claiming age relaxation under this sub-para would be required to produce a certificate in prescribed proforma in support of their claims clearly indicating that the degree of physical disability is 40% or more. In any case, the appointment of these candidates will be subject to their being found medically fit in accordance with the standards of medical fitness as prescribed by the Government for each individual posts to be filled by Direct Recruitment by Selection.
- The claim of the candidates for their belonging to SC/ST/OBC etc. categories will be considered subject to submission of self attested photocopies of their certificate in the prescribed format issued by the competent authority concerned in support of their claim. The closing date, for receipt of application i.e. 27/01/2017 will be treated as the date of reckoning for age.
 - Candidates should specifically note that the applications received after the closing date for any reason whatsoever (such as envelopes wrongly addressed, delivered elsewhere, postal delay etc.) will not be entertained. Any enclosure received separately subsequent to the receipt of the application cannot be connected therewith. No representation in this regard will be entertained.
 - Applications from Employees of Govt. Departments will be considered only if forwarded through proper channel along with vigilance clearance certificate certified by their employer that the applicant will be relieved within one month of the receipt of the appointment orders, if selected. However, advance copy of the application may be submitted before the closing date.
 - Candidate must ensure that he/she possesses educational qualification/experience in the relevant area as required in the category /post, for which he/she is applying, on the last date of receipt of application.
 - The posts will be governed by the New Pension Scheme applicable w.e.f. 01.01.2004.
 - Mere fulfilling the minimum eligibility criteria will not entitle a candidate to be called for written/typing tests etc.
 - Candidate must indicate as to whether any of their blood/close relatives is working in CSIR or in any other National Labs./ Institutes of CSIR.
 - Persons with disabilities (PWD) fulfilling the eligibility conditions prescribed under GOI instructions are encouraged to apply even for those posts which are not reserved for the PWD category.

 - In case candidate wants to modify/withdraw the application there is a 'CANCEL' option to cancel the online application. Please note that application once cancelled will not be retrieved at any stage. If you have cancelled the application, please reapply before the closure of Application Date as per advertisement. Please remember to take fresh print out after modifying any details.
 - Candidates are required to arrange for a crossed Demand Draft for Rs.100/ drawn on any nationalized bank and valid for at least 3 months in favour of "Director, CSIR-NEIST, Jorhat" payable at Jorhat. The following details must be filled up on back side of Demand Draft (i) Candidate's Name, (ii) Candidate's Category, (iii) Post Code Applied For. The Candidates belonging to SC/ST/PWD/Women/CSIR Employees/Abroad Candidates category are exempted from submission of application fee.
 - In case of universities/Institute awarding CGPA/SGPA/OGPA grades etc., candidates are requested to convert the same in to percentage based on the formula as per their university/institute.
 - Duly filled Application form (in case of Online mode of application; print-out of the computer generated application and in case of Manual mode of application; properly filled up application in prescribed format) duly accompanied by attested copies of the certificates, mark sheets, testimonials in support of age, education qualifications, experience and caste certificate, if applicable along with one recent passport size self-signed photograph and PWD Certificate should be sent in an envelope superscribed "APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF _____ (Post Code _____) of Advt. Candidates applying for more than one post must submit separate application form for each post indicating the Code No. of the post.
 - Application once made will not be allowed to be withdrawn and on any count, nor can it be held in reserve for any other recruitment or selection process.
 - Applications from employees of Government Departments will be considered only if forwarded through proper channel, certified by the employer that the applicant, if selected will be relieved within one month of the receipt of the appointment orders. Also, vigilance clearance should also be recorded. However, advance copy of the application may be submitted before the closing date. Applications routed through proper channel should reach CSIR-NEIST, Jorhat at the earliest.
 - Candidates should specifically note that the applications received after the closing date for any reason whatsoever (such as envelopes wrongly addressed, delivered elsewhere, postal delay etc.) will not be entertained by CSIR-NEIST, Jorhat.
 - Incomplete applications (i.e. without photograph, unsigned and application fee, applicable testimonials etc.) will not be entertained and will be summarily rejected.
 - In case of large number of applications received, CSIR-NEIST Jorhat shall be at liberty to devise such screening criteria as required for shortlisting of the candidates to be called for written test & trade test/skill test. The same shall be notified for all concerned on the CSIR-NEIST website.
 - Only outstation candidates called and found eligible for trade test/skill test will be paid to and fro single second class rail fare from the actual place of undertaking the journey or from the normal place of their residence whichever is nearer to Jorhat Railway Station on production of Rail Tickets/Rail Ticket Number or any other proof of journey.
 - Any discrepancy found between the information given in application and as evident in original documents will make the candidate ineligible for appearing in interview. Such candidate will not be paid any fare.
 - Canvassing in any form and/or bringing any influence political or otherwise will be treated as a disqualification for the post.
