

# Spike in infections across State

## 19 new COVID-19 cases detected in Dhubri

### CORRESPONDENT

DHUBRI May 30: As many as 19 new COVID-19 cases have been detected in Dhubri on Friday and Saturday evening, taking the total number of positive cases to 34 in the district.

All these persons have recently returned to the district from other parts of the country and have been quarantined.

Among these new cases, five persons have been found COVID-19 positive on Saturday and quarantined at Sapangram College.

However, these five positive patients from Dhubri will

be kept in a specially made isolation ward at Dhubri Civil Hospital, informed medical officials here.

On Friday night, three persons identified as Monowar Ali (24), Sandul Hoque (34) and Raju Ahmed (20) were found COVID-19 positive. They were released from a quarantine centre at Dumardafra on May 28.

While another Saldam Hussain (23), Nur Islam (22) and Ruzman Ali (24) were quarantined in Jawahar Hindi School located in Dhubri for being diagnosed with COVID-19 on Friday night.

Persons named Sanji Sen (18), Sujan Sen (23) and Ruhadas Sen (52), all are residents of Paporchar village under Agomoni Circle, were found COVID-19 positive.

24-year-old Inamal Hoque from Koinati village, Golapi Bili (23) and her husband Yotun Ali (31), residents of Soto Parali, who returned from Haryan, were also found positive for the disease.

Another Anowar Hussain (20) from Similari village and Shih Alon (26) from Suapata village have also tested COVID-19 positive. They came from Uttar Pradesh and were sent to their homes on May 27 from a quarantine centre.

## 17 more test positive in Tinsukia dist

DOOMDOOMA, May 30: With the detection of 17 new cases on Friday night, the number of COVID-19 positive persons in Tinsukia district has risen to 21.

Among the 17 positive persons, 14 were quarantined at the Doomdooma Marwari Panchayat Bhawan. All of them have returned from Chennai.

Three other positive persons are from Sadiya who were quarantined at the Multidisciplinary Skill Development Centre at Chapakhowa. Two among them had returned from Chennai while the others had returned from Hyderabad.

All the 17 positive persons have been shifted to Lokapaya Gopinath Bordoloi Civil Hospital at Tinsukia for treatment.

## 3 more cases in Barpeta

BARPETA, May 30: Three more persons tested COVID-19 positive in Barpeta district today, taking the tally of positive cases to 15.

All the three were returnees and inmates of the Bhabanur Andakhil College quarantine centre in the district.

2 new COVID-19 cases in Darrang

14 patients discharged

Tiwa groups demand arrest of council CEM

The Tiwa Yuba Chitra Parishad, Tiwa Suraksha Samiti, Sadou Tiwa Mahila Sabha, Morigoon district unit of Koch Rajpoongshi Samiti, Sadou Chutia Jati Samitiani and a few other groups in a joint statement raised questions on the role of Morigoon police in not arresting Manta in this regard till date.

A case was registered at the Morigoon Police Station against Manta in 2018.

The Gauhati High Court had recently directed the Morigoon SP to probe into the allegations of graft by Manta.

## COVID testing facility inaugurated in Jorhat

### Golaghat has presently 163 active cases: Himanta Biswa Sarma

JORHAT, DERGAAO, May 30: State Minister for Health and Family Welfare, Education and Finance Himanta Biswa Sarma today inaugurated the COVID-19 testing laboratory at the CSIR-North East Institute of Science and Technology on Saturday.

The CSIR-NEIST laboratory became the eighth laboratory for testing COVID-19 in the State. Speaking to media persons on the occasion, Sarma said

the NEIST laboratory was the first facility outside of the six medical colleges in the State and the laboratory of Indian Council of Medical Research at Lalbarga, Dibrugarh district.

"We have till date tested 85,000 people in Assam and within two or three days hope to complete one lakh tests and the addition of this (NEIST) laboratory will further the testing capacity," he added.

He informed that by June 15, Assam is expected to have a total of 12 testing facilities.

Meanwhile, Jorhat Deputy

Commissioner Roshal A Korati informed that with five new positive cases being detected today, the total number of cases in the district has gone up to 16 with 11 active cases.

Korati said all the five persons reached Jorhat on May 26 and were in quarantine. She added that all of them were asymptomatic and shifted to JMCH.

Meanwhile, Sarma also visited the Golaghat Civil Hospital today and interacted with the patients there. He informed that there are presently 163 active cases in the district.

## CM takes stock of erosion mitigation works in Nalbari

GUWAHATI, May 30: Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal visited Nalbari district and took stock of the land erosion mitigation works being undertaken at the erosion-hit areas near an embankment along the Brahmaputra at Doulsal-Larkuchi in Borbhetri constituency on Saturday.

He directed the Water Resources department to complete the repair work on a war footing.

It may be mentioned here that the Water Resources department has already taken initiatives to protect the erosion-hit areas.

Talking to reporters on the

sidelines of his visit, Sonowal said directions have already been given to repair the breach.

He also said when the State is reeling under floods, construction of an all-new embankment is not feasible, and therefore, his government has taken swift actions to repair any breach on the embankment caused by floods.

He also informed that though floating of tenders, giving work orders and beginning of construction work have begun well ahead of COVID-19 pandemic, the resultant lockdown has caused a delay in completing the construction and repair work.

The Chief Minister said

through the state government is handling hard agri-cases COVID-19, flood and erosion, cyclone and African swine fever, the government would get rid of all the problems with the support of the people.

He also said to consider erosion as a national problem, the state government has already written to the chairman of 15th Finance Commission.

MLAs Narayan Deka, Ashok Sharma and Rituparna Barua, Nalbari Deputy Commissioner Binrat Bhuvan Dev Choudhary, SP Amanjeet Singh and senior officers of the government were present during the Chief Minister's visit.

## Rehabilitation of flood-hit people sought

DIBRUGARH, May 30: Flood Erosion Resistance Struggle Forum, a body of the flood and erosion affected people in Dibrugarh and Tinsukia districts, has demanded that all the flood and erosion affected people along the Brahmaputra, particularly within the Chabua revenue circle, be rehabilitated by the

state government.

The office-bearers of the forum after visiting the flood-affected areas like Rongmoita, Tengbani, Geraki and Morigoon near Muliak Gaon, the native village of Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal, today said the situation in these areas has become critical due to riverbank erosion.

Binod Kedia, President of the forum, told The Assam Tribune that after the first wave of flood, erosion has rendered several families homeless. Tracts of agricultural fields have also been affected.

Resides all these, about 92 families spending nights on roads are still without food and proper shelter, Kedia added.

The forum has urged upon the government to take up relief and rehabilitation works on a war footing.

## Water levels of rivers rising in Hailakandi

HAILAKANDI, May 30: With the water level of the major rivers rising drastically following incessant rains in the last few days in Hailakandi, the administration here is all set to tackle flood situation amid the coronavirus outbreak in the district.

The administration has directed the water resources and other line departments to remain on alert for dealing with the situation.

The water level of the Dholeswari river is rising considerably and flooding at 24.98

The water levels of the Katakhal and Barak rivers recorded by the Water Resources department at Matjung and Guarnama sites as on Saturday morning were at 18.20 metres and 15.97 metres, below the danger levels of 20.27 metres and 19.83 metres, respectively.

Hailakandi town and its adjoining areas have experienced good showers. Water has submerged some low lying areas of the town.
